NEGOTIATION AGREEMENT

INSTITUTION:

NEW MEXICO INSTITUTE OF MINING AND TECHNOLOGY SOCORRO, NEW MEXICO 87801

The Facilities and Administrative (F&A) cost rates contained herein are for use on grants, contracts and/or other agreements issued or awarded to The New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology by all Federal Agencies of the United States of America, in accordance with the cost principles mandated by 2 CFR Part 200. These rates shall be used for forward pricing and billing purposes for the New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology Fiscal Year 2019. This rate agreement supersedes all previous rate agreements/determinations for Fiscal Year 2019.

DISTRIBUTION BASES

(a) Modified Total Direct Cost (MTDC), as defined in 2 CFR Part 200, consists of all salaries and wages, fringe benefits, materials and supplies, services, travel and subawards up to the first \$25,000 each subaward (regardless of the period covered by the subaward). Equipment, capital expenditures, charges for patient care and tuition remission, rental costs, scholarships, and fellowships, participant support costs as well as the portion of each subaward in excess of \$25,000 shall be excluded.

SECTION II: GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- A. LIMITATIONS: Use of the rates set forth under Section I is subject to any statutory or administrative limitations and is applicable to a given grant, contract or other agreement only to the extent that funds are available and consistent with any and all limitations of cost clauses or provisions, if any, contained therein. Acceptance of any or all of the rates agreed to herein is predicated upon all the following conditions: (1) that no costs other than those incurred by the recipient/contractor were included in its indirect cost pool as finally accepted and that all such costs are legal obligations of the recipient/contractor and allowable under governing cost principles; (2) that the same costs that have been treated as indirect costs are not claimed as direct costs; (3) that similar types of costs, in like circumstances, have been accorded consistent accounting treatment; (4) that the information provided by the recipient/contractor, which was used as the basis for the acceptance of the rates agreed to herein and expressly relied upon by the Government in negotiating the said rates, is not subsequently found to be materially incomplete or inaccurate.
- B. ACCOUNTING CHANGES: The rates contained in Section I of this agreement are based on the accounting system in effect at the time this agreement was negotiated. Changes to the method(s) of accounting for costs, which affects the amount of reimbursement resulting from the use of these rates, require the written approval of the authorized representative of the cognizant negotiating agency for the Government prior to implementation of any such changes. Such changes include but are not limited to changes in the charging of a particular type of cost from indirect to direct. Failure to obtain such approval may result in subsequent cost disallowances.
- C. FIXED RATES WITH CARRY-FORWARD PROVISIONS: The fixed rates contained in this agreement are based on estimates of the costs for FY 2019. When actual costs for this fiscal year are determined, adjustments will be applied to a subsequent rate negotiation to recognize the difference between the FY 2019 estimated costs used to establish the fixed rates and the negotiated actual FY 2019 costs.

E. USE BY OTHER FEDERAL AGENCIES: The rates set forth in Section I hereof were negotiated in accordance with and under the authority set forth in 2 CFR Part 200. Accordingly, such rates shall be applied to the extent provided in such regulations to grants, contracts and other agreements to which 2 CFR Part 200 is applicable, subject to any limitations in part A of this section. Copies of this document may be provided by either party to other Federal agencies to provide such agencies with documentary notice of this agreement and its terms and conditions.

F. SPECIAL REMARKS:

- 1. The rates included in Section I are not intended to be applied to Intergovernmental Personal Act (IPA) costs. If New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology elects to seek reimbursement of F&A costs associated with IPA agreements, then the New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology and the Office of Naval Research shall establish a special F&A rate for IPA agreements in accordance with the provisions of 2 CFR Part 200.
- 2. New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology uses off-campus rates for sponsored projects that are conducted: (1) in leased facilities where space-related costs, e.g. rent, utilities, and maintenance, are charged directly to the project, or (2) in facilities made available at no cost to the project by another university, the federal government or by any other non-institute organization.
- 3. The Government's agreement with the rates set forth in Section I is not an acceptance of New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology's accounting practices or methodologies. Any reliance by the Government on cost data or methodologies submitted by New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology is on a non-precedence-setting basis and does not imply Government acceptance.
